



CLUE 1 - Gather your supplies

1. A stamp set/s of your choice that have images and sentiments.
Coordinating Punch or Dies - If you aren't using die cut or punched images, your image/sentiment needs to fit on a 1½" (3.81cm) wide piece.
2. Ink pads to coordinate with either your patterned paper or coloured card stock.
3. Coloured Card Base - ½ an A4 sheet (14.9cm x 21cm or 5⅞" x 8¼")
- fold in half to make a 10.5cm x 14.9cm card (approx 4⅛" x 5⅞")
4. White or Vanilla card stock -
 - 10cm x 14cm or approx 5½" x 4" - 2 pieces
 - OPTIONAL: scraps for stamping die cut images on sentiments
5. Designer Series Paper (DSP) (Patterned paper) - design no 1
 - 1¼" x 3" - 3 pieces
6. Designer Series Paper (DSP) (Patterned paper) - different design
 - 1" x 4" or 2.54cm x 10.16cm - 1 piece
7. **OPTIONAL:** Coordinating ribbon, Bling, Wink of Stella
8. Basic Tools:
 - Silicon craft mat or non-stick baking paper
 - Paper snips
 - Bone Folder
 - Paper trimmer with scoring attachment or score board
 - Adhesive - multi-purpose glue
 - Dimensionals
 - blocks or a stampartus



CLUE 2

Stamp your greeting on the top left corner of your white/
vanilla piece with the ink of your choice.



CLUE 3

Add one of the 1¼" x 3" Designer Series Paper pieces to bottom LEFT corner of the one of the 10cm x 14cm white/vanilla piece with adhesive.

NOTE: Liquid glue is best as it gives you a little wriggle room

You want the left and bottom edges to be flush and exactly lined up.



CLUE 4

Add one of the 1¼" x 3" Designer Series Paper pieces to bottom RIGHT corner of the one of the 10cm x 14cm white/vanilla piece with adhesive.

You want the RIGHT and bottom edges to be flush and exactly lined up.



CLUE 5

Take the remaining strip of 1¼" x 3" Designer Series Paper (DSP) and centre it between the other two strips with the bottom edges flush.

There should/will be some white space in between the strips of DSP.



CLUE 6

Attach the different patterned DSP strip measuring 1"x4"
wide across the top of the 3 pieces of DSP.

Where you put it depends on how big your greeting is



CLUE 7

Add the Basic White/Vanilla and DSP to the front of your coloured cardstock base card with adhesive.



CLUE 8

Add the second piece of Basic White/Vanilla to the inside of your card with adhesive.



CLUE 9

There are many things you can now do to the front of your card 😊

Stamp Image and Fussy-cut/Die cut or punch an image and add it to the top right corner with dimensionals

AND/OR

Die-cut or punch a shape from DSP and affix it with dimensionals.

SO MANY POSSIBILITIES!!!



CLUE 10

embellish, Embellish, EMBELLISH your card with bling, wink of stella, ribbon, etc if you want to!

I did!

TIP:

If using bling, try to use odd numbers of embellishments (e.g. 3 or 5) - it is generally more pleasing to the eye.
